SCOPE OF SERVICES

GENERAL

Responsible for carrying out the necessary subsurface Soil exploration works in respect to the Project stated.

Upon completion of the subsurface exploration work activities, the Consultant shall submit their final report containing geotechnical/geological reports.

The Consultant shall be responsible for the reliability of the report presented.

THE SERVICES

Subsurface Soil Exploration Works

SCOPE OF PROJECT

The contractor shall provide all the labor, instrument/equipment materials and supplies, vehicles, bunkhouses, etc., necessary to perform satisfactorily the subsurface exploration herein required, following:



- Standard Penetration Test (SPT)
- Water Level Measurements
- Laboratory Testing and Analysis
- Preparation and submission of Reports

DETAILED EXPLORATION REQUIREMENTS / SPECIFICATIONS

Drilling and Sampling

Location and Number:

Five (5) boreholes shall be drilled at the Biogas Plant location. As shown in site plan with coordinate.



COORDINATE Benchmark -BM1 (24.8364574,67.2641325) Boreholes -BH1 (24.8331537,67.2644816) -BH2 (24.8338055,67.2651094) -1BH3 (24.8331559,67.265812) -BH4 (24.8357917,67.2670015)

Depth of Borings: The boreholes shall be drilled to a minimum depth of 10m and a maximum depth of 15 meter, stopping at or after 10m if bedrock has been encountered.

In sand, clay, and silt materials, advance the boreholes using the wash boring method, incorporating side-discharged chopping bits in between sampling sections. Utilize N-size casings when required. Thoroughly clean the washed section before each sampling run, ensuring minimal disturbance to the underlying soil. Drill a 100 mm (4") diameter hole using either wash boring or rotary drilling at the bottom of the borehole.

Embed a 100 mm diameter steel casing into the topsoil to a sufficient depth to prevent hole collapse and facilitate water circulation during wash boring. Use bentonite slurry to maintain an open borehole for sampling and testing.

Sampling Procedure: Collect undisturbed samples at 1.5-meter intervals in each borehole, employing hydraulic push using a drill machine, for soft and medium clay layers.

Perform sampling in accordance with ASTM D 1586 and ASTM D 1587 standards. Use a 50 cm split spoon sampler at one-meter intervals from the riverbed to the hard strata. Obtain disturbed samples using thin-walled tube samplers hydraulically in soft cohesive layers.

For rock formations, conduct core drilling using a diamond rotary drill method. Take core samples whenever encountering substantial information.

Immediately place the extracted core samples in labeled core boxes, arranged according to depth.

Standard Penetration Test (SPT)

Perform the test in ordinary soil encountered up to the specified depths. Use a 5.0 cm (2.0 in.) outside diameter split spoon sampler driven by a 63.6 kg (140 lbs.) hammer falling 76.0 cm (30 in.) at 1.50-meter intervals or closer if necessary.

Water Level Measurement

Measure the water level daily, both before and after encountering it in a borehole.

Laboratory Testing Analysis

Conduct laboratory testing on soil samples obtained from the boreholes to determine the basic properties of the subsoils. Follow ASTM standard procedures for the required tests. Refer to the table below for the types of tests performed in the laboratory and the corresponding standards followed.
